Only owners and families residing in Newport are permitted to fish. Guests must be accompanied by the owner. This applies to all amenities including the Boardwalk. Those who don't comply will be trespassing. The Board, as well as anyone, has the right to call the Sheriff's dept as appropriate.

Pets: A reminder that shots, etc. for pets are to be current. For nuisance situations (persistent barking, unleased animals, etc.), call the Sheriff's dept or Animal Control to address.
